Transfer Fee for dogs of recorded litters will be \$15.

DOG COLORS AND TERMS TO USE ON REGISTRATION APPLICATION

Patterns of base body colors. No consideration of merle or dilution.

Base Pattern: Solid, Bi (one color plus white) or Tri-(two colors plus white)

Base Colors (do not consider white). Black, Red, chocolate or Tan (dilute red is not tan)

Modifying gene traits (even a small patch should be considered) Merle , Dilute, ticking (yes, they can have 2 or more)

DESCRIPTIONS OF REGISTRATION LEVELS AND COLOR

Levels of Registry

Level 1: Regular registry.

Any dog with a signed certificate of transfer from the original breeder or from recorded litters can register their dog in the regular registry. The breeder will be contacted to confirm that terms of the purchase contract have been met for dogs in a recorded litter. Dogs in this register cannot have any offspring registered with the GCWR. The original breeder of this dog can sign an Advancement of Registry form for a temporary period or for life in order to advance the dog to Level 2 so that puppies may be registered and recorded.

Level 2: Breeding Stock Registry.

Dogs registered in the breeding stock level can have puppies registered with this registry. If a level 2 dog produces offspring that are considered healthy and a positive addition to the gene pool of the German Coolie then the dogs can be considered for the Foundation Registry. The performance of their offspring is strongly consideration for this advancement.

Level 3: Foundation Registry.

It is possible that movement to the Foundation Registry could occur years after the dog is no longer reproducing and can be done at the discretion of the registry. Dogs may be nominated directly to the registrar for consideration. This registry level is for those animals that have produced quality offspring and are considered to be foundation stock for the breed. Things taken into consideration are the hybrid vigor of the offspring. The offspring should be sound of body and of outstanding temperament. There should a variety of traits present in the offspring indicating a diversity of genetic make-up worth preserving.
